Hamilton County Schools has approved and authorizes nine charter schools in the district. Each school has a unique approach and strives to educate some of the district's most vulnerable students. For the past year, the newly added Charter Schools Coordinator has worked to develop close working relationships with each school's leadership team. Through open communication and transparency, there is a clear line from each charter to the supports they need in the various district departments.

- One charter school received Reward Status from the state for the 21-22 school year.
- Two charter schools Received Level 5 TVAAS scores for the 21-22 school year.
- One charter school expanded to add a feeder elementary school in 2022.
- One charter school expanded to add a feeder high school in 2022.
